"Test" ("Peirazo")- experience, trial. To try, test in either a good sense (Jn 6:6, 2Cor 13:5, Heb 11:17) or a bad one (Mt 16:1, 22:18, 35, 1Co 10:9); to tempt, test by solicitation to sin, entice, allure (1 Th 3:5, Jas 1:13,14). Involves entangling a person in sin or discovering what good or evil, weakness or strength, exists in a person

(Mt 16:1; 19:3; 22:18); or, making it manifest to the one tempted (2Cor 13:5, *examine*). (NT Lex Aids #4279, p. 1661)
